


Creating a Narrated Power Point, Exporting it to a video, and uploading it to Youtube

1. Prepare your slides	
2. SAVE	
3. Goto Slide Show > Record Slide Show	




<p>4. Click Record, Start talking. Advance Slide as you talk. Keep talking and advance sides until you complete your presentation</p>	
<p>5. Click Stop when done recording</p>	
<p>6. Click on upper right hand corner X to close</p>	
<p>7. Save your file</p>	
<p>8. Replay your power point. Slide Show > From Beginning</p>	
<p>9. If the Power Point is good, go to next step. If you need to record again, go back to Step 3.</p>	



<p>10. To save your file to Video format, goto File</p>		
<p>11. Click on Export Click on Create A Video Click on Create Video</p>		
<p>12. Click on Desktop Click on Save</p> <p>The file will be saved to Desktop.</p> <p>Note the Filename. In this example, it's "My presentation.mp4"</p>		


